## International news

**ANGOLA** - The Confederation of African Football officially "disqualified" and plans to punish the Togo national football team for failing to take part in the 2010 Africa Cup of Nations, despite the fatal machine gun attack on their team bus.



**EGYPT** - Tombs discovered near the great pyramids reinforce the theory that they were built by free workers rather than slaves.

**UNITED KINGDOM** - A Muslim group, Al-Muhajiroun, also known as Islam4UK, that recently caused outrage by proposing a demonstration in the town that receives the bodies of British war dead killed abroad, will be banned.

**BELGIUM** - Wolfgang Wodarg, the

Council of Europe's head of health affairs, claims that the 2009 flu pandemic was a "false pandemic" orchestrated by the pharmaceutical industry to sell vaccines.

**IRAN** - State media have accused Israel and the US of being involved in a bomb attack, which killed an Iranian physicist in Tehran.
