

World Cup: USA ready to take on England

RUSTENBURG - The Yanks are upbeat about their chances in the FIFA Soccer World Cup finals that start here later this year. This transpired from an interview with the team's media liaison, Michael Kammarman near Sun City on Wednesday last week, where he attended the FIFA pre-tournament team workshop. Delegates from the 32 teams competing in the upcoming tournament were present, where logistical arrangements around the event were discussed.

The US team will meet one of the tournament

favourites, England, in their first match at the Royal Bafokeng Stadium on Saturday, June 12. The United States football team, nicknamed the Yanks, will battle it out with England, Algeria and Slovenia in Group C. With only seven countries ever to have won the World Cup, he said reaching the second round of the tournament would be his team's main objective.

According to Michael, who is also an accomplished football player, there are many similarities between the US and England teams in terms of the type of game they play. He says this is partly due to the fact that the majority of

the team's top players are based at clubs in England.

Asked about his team's chances against England, he pointed out that in what is widely considered to be one of the greatest upsets in football history, the Yanks beat England 1-0 in their first World Cup match in Brazil in 1950. This followed a 3-1 loss against Spain in their first match. Michael also pointed out that the US beat Spain in their match at the Confederations Cup last year, finishing on top of the log in their group.

He said the members of the team were very impressed with the facilities in the country, especially the Royal Bafokeng Stadium, where they beat Egypt in the Confederations Cup. The players were also full of praise for the warm reception they had in Rustenburg.

Michael told the Rustenburg Herald that soccer in the US goes back a long way, with the US and Canada having played the first international match outside the United Kingdom, in 1885. On this occasion, Canada defeated the US 1-0 in Newark, New Jersey, but he says the US had its revenge the following year when it beat Canada 1-0. The United States played its first official international match under the auspices of US Soccer against Sweden in Stockholm

in 1916, when the USA won 2-3.

While soccer is not a major competitive sport in the United States, he stated that it is the biggest recreational sport, enjoying huge support. Michael said over the past few years, there has been a generational shift and many younger people now begin to show a keen interest in soccer, with more than 16 teams from all over the country competing in the Domestic League. The popularity of the game saw a particular upswing since the 1994 World Cup that took place in the USA. He also pointed out that the well-known soccer star of the 1970's, better known by his nickname, Pelé played soccer in the USA.

Michael said stars in the US team to look out for, are midfielders Clint Dempsey, Landon Donovan and Michael Bradley, who play for clubs in England and Germany. Other players to watch are the goalkeeper Tim Howard, who plays for Everton in England and defender and team captain, Carlos Bocanegra who plays for Rennes in France.
